What: DNow or Discipleship-Now is an in-town weekend retreat where students stay in the home of a church member with some of their closest friends, have in-home Bible studies led by qualified young adults, participate in service/mission projects and gather with several other church groups in our area for amazing worship sessions. It is intended to be a high impact weekend devoted to developing our students into more mature followers of Christ.



Cost: \$45

When: March 1-3 (See attached Schedule for more details)

Where: Students will stay in host homes and gather for worship services at FBC Douglasville. Your host home will contact you the week of DNow to coordinate details. Unless other arrangements are made all students will need to be pick up following the 10:45 worship service at FBC Douglasville.

Other details: If a student needs to leave at any time during the weekend, a <u>time away card</u> needs to be filled out. These cards must be signed by a parent and given to the Host on Friday night when your student arrives. They should only be leaving for work or school events such as basketball games, baseball practice, soccer, etc. If a card is not given to the Host and your student asks to leave, you will be called at home to give permission over the phone. Time away card is attached. DO NOT turn this card in to the youth office.
