INAUGURAL YEAR!

Runner's Camp is a one-week Christian day camp centered on the sport of track & field for kids ages 6-12 years old. Campers are divided into groups by age and gender. They report each morning to their assigned groups, where their adult age group leader teaches a short Gospel-based devotional. Following the devotion time, campers receive instruction in track & field events (and play some fun games too). At the end of the week, we host a track & field meet and let the campers compete against other campers their own age and gender. Parents are encouraged to come and watch their campers compete.

It is open to boys and girls ages 6-12 years of age. (5 year olds will be accepted as 6 year olds if the camper will turn 6 by July 1, 2018). The camp and track meet will be held at Douglas County High School.
