

We are excited about an upcoming opportunity to serve some of our IMB (International Mission Board) missionaries this Summer. We will be partnering with a few other churches and the IMB to provide a retreat in Northern Europe for about 100 missionary families serving in the Northern Africa area. Our church along with Dawson Memorial Church will be in charge of running the youth and children's portion of the retreat. We will be providing a camp/vbs type experience for these individuals, which includes: Bible study, worship, recreation, fellowship, games, small groups, etc. This is a great opportunity to minister to our missionaries and their families!

Applicants must meet the following requirement:

- At least 18 years old
- A baptized follower of Christ
- An active member of a local bible believing church
- Have a passport or be able to obtain one by Feb. 11

Other Trip Information:

We will likely depart on June 29th or late on June 28th and arrive home Sunday July 7th. Trip cost includes: airfare, ground transportation, hotel accommodations, any and all materials needed to complete our missions' projects, and breakfast and lunch once we arrive. You will be responsible for your own meals while traveling and for dinner each night. More details about this trip can be given in person and at a later date. Please contact Jamie Wynn. After signup we will have at least one informational / training meeting leading up to the trip.

Security: Because of the nature of this trip please be aware of a few important measures we will take for the protection of these missionary families. The exact location is on a need-to-know basis. The location can be shared person to person however it should not be in any print form and should not be posted on social media. The location should only be advertised (in print or verbally broadcast) as Northern Europe and the exact location / names of the missionary families should not be mentioned. We know that people will probably need to raise funds for their trip, but we ask that if you are going to advertise it as a mission trip, that you only do it person to person or by letter / email and not on social media.
