- Females when swimming, you are expected to wear a one-piece suit or a two-piece suit that covers your stomach. If you wear a two-piece the top must be stitched to the bottom so that the top does not come up. Please remember that modesty is the key here. That means that even if a student wears a one piece that student may be asked to put on a t-shirt and/or shorts if the leaders deem that suit too revealing.
